#### **BACKGROUND AND HISTORY**

- Food is a mandatory component of customs
- Traditionally, Palau was self-sufficient in food
- In contrast today, Palau is heavily dependent on imported food
- The dietary shift from "traditional" foods to imported foods erodes the quality of life





# What type of research/educ./dev. is necessary over the next 10 yrs?

- Promote local produce and producers.
- Livestock feed mill development.
- Promote farming as a noble profession.
- Meat inspection and quality control standards.
- Reorientation/reeducation to permaculture.



# What will be needed to create stronger local food systems ?

- Fruit fly eradication.
- Consistency and variety of produce and livestock.
- Farmers/central/national market.
- Incentives such as tax breaks.
- Persuasive unrelentless champion(s) for agriculture.
- National agricultural plan.



## What are the local food production trends on your island?

- More pests less food production.
- More imports less production.
- More foreign and illegal producers less production.
- More regulations less production.
- More taxes less production.
- More thieves less food production.

#### Can Palau's farmers produce enough food for its people 5-10 years from now?

- YES. The resources and interest and demand are there.
- It is our politics and poor planning that is holding back the development.

## What projects should be emphasized if there was additional \$1 million ?

- SARE est. in Palau a Resource, Grantmanship and Training Center.
- SARE sponsor a permaculture designers training and certification program.
- Invest in livelihoods (not farm fronts) committed to dev. of ag. as model farms ...
- BOA assistance to invest in different areas in agriculture that can really help boost up the production and operation.



## Has SARE been a success in your area of influence?

- Farmers are unaware of SARE, its state coordinator, its contact person in Palau...
- There has been no publicity of SARE for almost 20 years. Grossly underserved.
- Only three grants were approved.
- State coordinator is 1000+ miles away.
- The writing, reporting and documentation turn off many farmers.
- SARE Resource, Grantmanship & Training Ctr. may design/implement marketing/publicity action plan.
